**Historical Sketch:** Kingston Library Association was organized in 1871, and gathered together some 1,850 books. The Lend-A-Hand Club of Kingston, comprised chiefly of school children, formed a free library in 1890 with money from entertainments given by the club. These books were kept at a local store and were available every evening during business hours. These organizations turned over their collections to the Town of Kingston and disbanded upon the creation of the Frederic C. Adams Public Library in 1898.

Funds for the Public Library were made available by the will of Frederic C. Adams, after the death of his widow in 1895. The Library building was erected in 1879 –98 and dedicated August 4, 1898. Joseph Everett Chandler designed the building and Mrs. George T. Adams and her son Horatio Adams, the sister-in-law and nephew of Frederic C. Adams, donated the building lots. The building completely furnished cost \$14,000. 3, 809 books and 26 periodicals were originally installed. Over the years the Library and its collections grew. In 1964-65, an addition was made to the original building.

By 1994, the Library and its collections had outgrown the Adams building and in December the Library moved directly across the street into the former AT&T building. The Library is currently operating from this location.

**Scope and Content note:** The scope of the Kingston Public Library Papers Collection covers a span of over 100 years of operation and service to the Town of Kingston and its community by the Kingston Public Library.

This Collection of Library Papers begins with the history of the Library: from the conception through the execution of establishment. A number of historical sketches (1:1) exist, which provide detailed descriptions, from a number of different viewpoints. Within the Collection there also are a number of legal documents, including wills and deeds (1:2). A large number of these documents focus on the original construction of the building (1:3), finances (1:4), equipment and maintenance throughout the years (2:7) and the addition to the Library in 1964 (2:8).

With the move of the Library in 1994, there was a great deal of controversy raised over the reuse of the F.C. Adams building (3:14, 3:15). There is also extensive information regarding the original construction of the Adams building by architect J.E. Chandler (3:13) and the eventual acceptance onto the National Register of Historic Buildings (2:12).

This Collection is abundant in the number of documents existing from a variety of previous programs sponsored by the Library (2:9, 3:20), including special events such as the Children's Room 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration (2:11) and the Library Centennial Celebration (3:17). The Collection is also strong in its focus on the Local History Room and the activities of the Local History Room (3:19).

Though the Collection is primarily text based, there are a small number of postcards depicting the Adams building (box 5) and photographs (box 5) depicting the evolution of the Library as an institution servicing the community. The Collection also contains VHS tapes (3:20), original library cards (1:1), bookmarks (3:20) and more.
