Historical sketch: The catalogues in this Collection, which cover 1901, 1902, 1905 and 1909, were compiled under the supervision of Henry B. Maglathlin, based upon the card catalogue originally compiled by Miss Edith Kathleen Jones, of Cambridge, MA in 1899. The Memorial Press of Plymouth published the pamphlets in 1901. The classification system was based on Dewey decimal classification system. Additional supplements were published, containing updates to the collection, as well as a current listing of the members of the Board of Trustees.

Scope and content: The *Catalogue of 1901* contains a listing of the Board of Trustees (1901), a preface (containing a brief history of the Library), an explanation of the classification system, rules and regulations, a list of contents, and the catalogue.
